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## BACKGROUND HISTORY OF KAELO TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL COLLEGE

Kaelo Technical and Vocational College is a public Technical and Vocational Education and Training institution established under the Technical and Vocational Education and Training Act No. 29 of 2013, which provides for the establishment of Technical Training Institutes across the country. The College is located in Igembe North Constituency and is the first public post-secondary institution in the Igembe region.

The College commenced operations in September 2019 with an enrolment of fourteen (14) trainees and six (6) trainers. Since its inception, the institution has experienced steady growth in enrolment, technical programmes, infrastructure, and human resource capacity. From an initial enrolment of fourteen trainees, the student population has grown to over one thousand two hundred and fifty (1250) trainees, with the number expected to increase following the ongoing expansion of training opportunities and the introduction of Competency-Based Education and Training programmes.

Kaelo TVC has established seven technical departments namely: Information Communication Technology and Computing, Business Studies, Agriculture, Mechanical Engineering, Building and Civil Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, and Institutional Management. The College offers a wide range of CBET programmes aimed at equipping trainees with practical skills and competencies required in the labour market.

The institution has positioned itself as a Centre of Excellence in Mechanical Engineering (Production Option) and continues to strengthen its capacity through infrastructure development, ICT integration, and partnerships with key stakeholders. The establishment of the Jitume Digital Laboratory has enhanced digital literacy and access to online services. The College also collaborates with institutions such as the Kenya Universities and Colleges Central Placement Service (KUCCPS), Higher Education Loans Board (HELB), Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority (TVETA), industry players, and development partners to improve access, quality, and relevance of training.

The development of practical workshops in Civil Engineering, particularly Plumbing and Masonry, will further strengthen hands-on training. We also envisage a modern Electrical Engineering workshop equipped with appropriate training equipment, ensuring that our learners acquire competencies using technologies and equipment that reflect the realities of the workplace.

We cannot overlook the enormous potential of our hospitality, fashion and beauty programmes. The development of modern Catering and Accommodation facilities will support quality practical training while creating opportunities for income generation. Likewise, a modern Fashion Design workshop will provide an environment for garment production, creativity, entrepreneurship and innovation. The establishment of a dedicated Cosmetology workshop will similarly enable learners to develop practical competencies while preparing them to establish and grow their own enterprises.

### **Ladies and gentlemen,**

The transformation we envision for Kaelo TVC goes beyond infrastructure and equipment. We want to build a productive TVET institution. An institution where a student in Mechanical Engineering can make a product; where an Automotive student can diagnose and repair a vehicle; where a Plumbing or Masonry student can undertake real construction work; where an Electrical student can install and maintain modern systems; where a Fashion student can produce garments and where hospitality and cosmetology students can deliver services that meet industry standards.

This is the essence of Training + Production + Enterprise.

Our institutions must become centres of production, innovation, entrepreneurship and community service. Equipment must be utilised. Workshops must be active. Production units must generate value. Learners must graduate not only with certificates, but with demonstrable skills and the confidence to create opportunities for themselves and others.

To achieve this transformation, partnerships will remain critical. I encourage Kaelo TVC to continue strengthening collaboration with Government agencies, industry, development partners and other stakeholders. Such partnerships will help us mobilise resources for modern infrastructure, appropriate equipment, industry exposure, innovation and sustainable skills development.

I also urge the management and staff of the College to embrace a culture of accountability, innovation and productivity. Every piece of equipment procured must serve its intended purpose. Every workshop developed must be utilised. Every partnership must translate into tangible opportunities for our learners and the surrounding community.
